- Do not install or allow anyone to install this product if there are any questions about the installation process.
- Never attempt to install this product if any of the components are damaged or have any unauthorized modifications.
- All persons should be trained. The owner is responsible for training the users.
- Wear the appropriate personal protective equipment during installation.
- Wear hearing protection.
- Wear safety glasses.
- Wear a dust mask to avoid breathing dust.
- Never allow children, unskilled or improperly trained people to participate in the installation process.


# **Tear Drop Privacy Latch Installation**


NOTE: The Tear Drop Privacy Latch is not a security lock and must be used with a door guide to ensure proper functionality.


The Tear Drop Privacy Latch can be installed with the latch mounted to the end of the sliding barn door or on the door jamb.

#### Instructions are

1. Place the catch at the desired height on either the inside of the sliding barn door or the door jamb (depending on your installation preference).







- 3. Align the Mounting plate with the top of the Catch's channel and affix to either the sliding barn door or the door jamb using the included screws (5) through the mounting plate's middle hole.
- 4. Place the flat washers over the top and bottom holes, place the latch on top and of the mounting plate and affix to either the sliding barn door or the door jamb using the included screws (5), leaving enough slack for the mounting plate to move freely.
